- Angels' Arms is the proud recipient of the 2005 Ladue News Charity of the Year award in the Women and Children category and also the Ameristar "Reaching Out to the Region" Award in 2007. Foster Dad Jesse Hughes received the Bank of America Community Hero Award in 2005.
- Angels' Arms collaborates with other St. Louis non-profit agencies. The children of Angels' Arms benefit from the services of Big Brothers Big Sisters, Foster Care and Adoptive Coalition and CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates).
- Angels' Arms has appeared on all of the St. Louis television stations (KSDK, KMOV, KTVI, KPLR) and radio stations, and has been featured in the St. Louis Post Dispatch, St. Louis Business Journal, The Suburban Journal, St. Louis Woman Magazine and many more publications.
